Under FIP Regulations, President Tay is ineligible for a third term and must stand down at the next FIP Congress in late 2018.

At the recent Korean Congress in Seoul, Bernie was elected to FIP Vice President and currently has responsibility for postal history, astrophilately, jury apprentices, seminars and education, plus legal matters and regulations. I'm sure I join all Australian collectors in wishing Mr Beston the very best for the election taking place next year. His candidacy is endorsed by both the FIAP and the Australian Philatelic Federation.

I hope that the busy weeks ahead bring you and your family a very safe and happy Christmas and New Year.

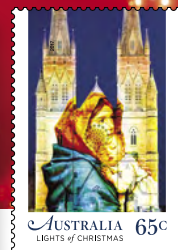

Every Christmas since 2010, St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney, has been host to the Lights of Christmas, a digital animated light and sound display that illuminates the church with themes of peace, joy and goodwill. A highlight of this popular event is the projection of paintings of the Madonna and Child. The 65c stamp shows the façade of the cathedral projected with a copy of the *Madonnina or Madonna of the*

Streets by Italian artist Roberto Ferruzzi (1853–1934). The \$2.30 stamp shows a projection of the *Small Cowper Madonna* by Renaissance artist Raphael (1483–1520), painted in oil on panel around 1505. For many who do not celebrate the birth of Christ, the three non-religious stamps mark the festive season as a time to gather with family and friends in a spirit of peace and understanding.

Shipwrecks

Since the 1600s more than 8,000 shipwrecks have been recorded in Australian waters. The earliest of these is the East India Shipping Company vessel *Pyralis*, which was wrecked in 1622 on the north-west coast of Western Australia. There are wrecks associated with major events from Australian history, including the loss of the First Fleet flagship *HMS Sirius* off Newcastle in 1790, the *SS Endeavour* in 1863, and the tragic wartime sinking of the *HMAS Sydney* in 1911. The latter carried 843 lives and became the greatest maritime disaster in Australian waters. These wrecks possess significant educational value, providing fascinating insights into shipping and life at sea, as well as broader social and economic conditions of the time.

Some shipwrecks also possess substantial archaeological value. Shipwrecks that are more than 75 years old are automatically protected under legislation, and there are more than half a million shipwreck artefacts that come under the legislative protection scheme. When such shipwrecks exist to preserve the site and protect against looting, there is, however, some allowance for permit-based diving and even for trade in certain artefacts such as coins.

Each stamp in the Shipwrecks stamp issue features a painting depicting historically significant shipwreck events and artefacts that were retrieved from the wreck, highlighting the purpose and context of the voyage: a valuable silver coin features with the trade ship *Zuytdorp*, a night-glass document with the luxury paddle steamer *Comet*, and a pistol with the tragic *HMS Pandora*.

During the 17th and 18th centuries, the Dutch East India Company (VOC) controlled the seas. Several of its trade ships, including *Zuytdorp* in 1712, came to grief on the treacherous Western Australian coast near Shark Bay. As well as carrying various trade goods, *Zuytdorp* was carrying a highly valuable load of silver coins. Coins and other wreck-related items were sighted heavily visual areas in 1922. In 1954, these coins, identified by the Dutch East India Company, were found to have come from *Zuytdorp*. The wreck itself was finally located in 1964, more than one century after the ship's disappearance. The wreck's location suggests there were survivors and that some may have stayed in the area. A protection zone encloses the wreck site, managed by the Western Australian Museum.

When William Bligh, the overboarded captain of the *HMS Bounty*, returned to England in 1780 to report the now famous mutiny, the *HMS Endeavour* was dispatched to capture as many of the mutineers as possible. The crew captured 18 of 25 mutineers, but disaster struck during the homeward journey. The *Endeavour* sank on 29 August 1791 on the outer Great Barrier Reef, despite the efforts of the boat and ship's crew to save her. Thirty-five lives were lost during the wrecking, including four prisoners. Back in

England, the 10 surviving prisoners were tried and found guilty of mutiny. While Captain Bligh and Captain Edwards were automatically court-martialed for the losses of the *Bounty* and *Endeavour*, both were acquitted and Bligh went on to become the governor of New South Wales in 1806.

The *Pandora* was not discovered until November 1977, almost 200 years after it was wrecked. An official survey and expert analysis concluded that the wreck is possibly the most intact 18th-century wreck in Australian waters. Thousands of significant artefacts have been recovered from the wreck and form part of the Queensland Museum collection, including Pacific items collected by the *Pandora* crew while searching for the mutineers. A protection zone exists around the wreck, managed by the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection, Queensland.

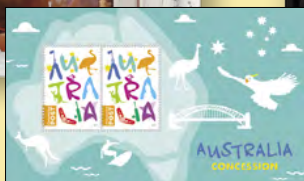
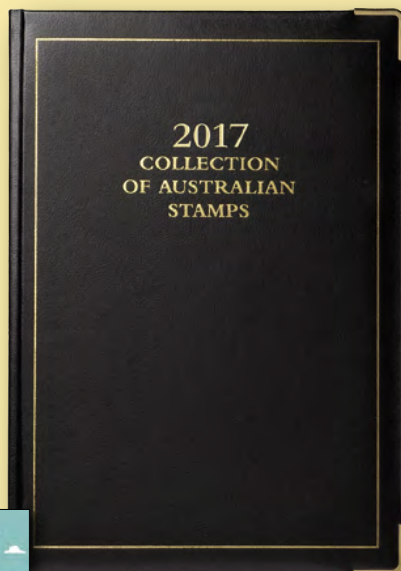
The 1880s signalled the beginning of the steamship era in the Australian colonies. Even the wrecking of the much-anticipated luxury international paddle-steamer *Comet*, on 1 January 1884, on the east coast of Victoria, led to the slow but steady transition to steam shipping. The wreck was reported widely in local newspapers, which also alerted settlers to the rich grazing land of what is now Gippsland.

Comet was carrying 80 passengers and crew, including prominent bankers and business people, and a valuable cargo of furs, pelts and baggage. All on board were saved, thanks in large part to the valiant efforts of five crew members, who bravely battled strong winds to reach Port Phillip Heads to sound the alarm. The cargo was lost, thrown overboard in an attempt to save the ship. The *Comet* wreck site is one of the most significant maritime archaeological sites in Victoria and the oldest located steamship wreck in Australia.

When Dutch-born artist Adrian De Jong conceived of painting the wrecking of the *Zuytdorp* he had much to consider, especially as there were no survivor accounts. The artist also had to think about the weather and other circumstances, like how the ship itself may have looked like, including the detailed stern typical to VOC ships of the era. The painting of the *HMS Pandora*, part of the Queensland Museum collection, is by renowned maritime artist Oswald Bastert. It is based, in part, on an 18th-century etching by Lieutenant Colonel Batty, which in turn is based on a sketch by *Pandora* survivor Peter Heywood.

Maritime artist Ian Mearns was commissioned by Australia Post to produce his evocative rendition of the wrecking of the *Comet*. When the remnants of the canvas were taken to the *Comet* wrecked further from the shore than depicted, the painting captures the mood and conditions at the time of the wrecking event, as well as the likelihood of the vessel itself of which there are no known surviving images. There were no big storms or ocean swells that day, just an unfortunate meeting with a sandbar.

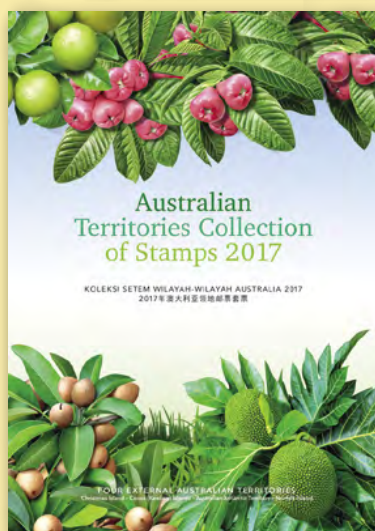

Occupational hazards include the island's ubiquitous red crabs, who are likely to steal golf balls in mid-play, so Santa's elves have safeguarded the balls by fashioning them into a splendid Christmas tree garlanded with

tinsel. Caddy Rudolf is a little dubious about Santa's golfing prowess and gives him a few tips as jubilant boobies, frigatebirds and Golden Bosuns career overhead. If Santa's game improves, he's thinking of returning to the tropical island in May to take part in the Christmas Island Open! In recognition of the island's name, Christmas Island Christmas stamps are issued every year. This year's issue continues the popular Santa Claus theme first adopted in 1984.



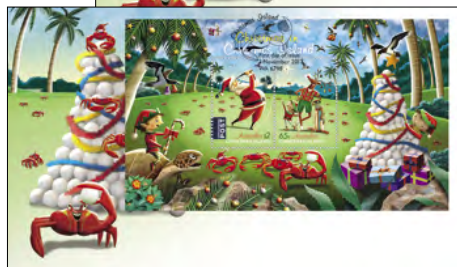

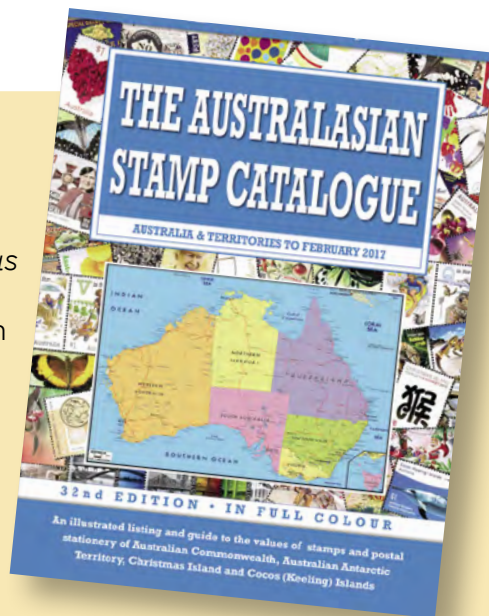
